Talent to Teach in FE is a unique project, funded by the Education and Training Foundation (ETF), that aims to promote teaching in Further Education (FE) as a career choice and encourage individuals to consider a future in the sector.

Placements will be available for:

- Second year, final year undergraduate and postgraduate students; and
- Individuals who may be unemployed, underemployed or in redundancy situations who have technical skills valuable to FE.

This is an exciting opportunity for FE providers to invite these individuals into their organisations where they can showcase the diverse and rewarding career opportunities that exist in the sector, raising awareness of FE as a possible career option for these individuals who may never have considered teaching. The programme is open to FE providers across England.

By completing a placement with a Further Education provider, we hope that it will spark an interest in teaching within the sector and possibly enable some students and individuals to find employment with their placement provider or other FE provider.

THE BENEFITS

You will:

- help to raise the profile of FE and establish a potential pipeline of entrants to the FE sector;
- encourage Higher Education (HE) institutions to promote opportunities in FE teaching;
- expose local people with talent to the sector, and raise awareness of the range of possible career opportunities that exist;
- provide undergraduates and postgraduate students with an understanding of the skills and knowledge they need to pursue a career in FE and increase their employability skills; and
- develop stronger links and partnership working between FE and HE, and with local employers.

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HOW DOES IT WORK?

- We will help you plan and prepare work placements for eligible individuals from now until the end of March 2023.
- Placements will consist of 40 hours work experience and will include a variety of activities to give a realistic and supported introduction to FE.
- We will provide guidance around the shape of the 40-hour placement, and the mentoring support required.
- You will name a member of staff, who will act as your placement coordinator.
- We will work closely with HE providers, local and national employers and other organisations to recruit individuals and match them with the most appropriate placement.
- In return, you will receive £300 per placement.
