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



Scheme Overview



- Cyber Essentials is a government-backed scheme launched in 2014 and overseen by the National Cyber Security Centre
- IASME is the sole Accreditation Body that oversees over 200 Certification Bodies, such as Protos Networks
- Encourages organisations to adopt good practices in information security and when properly implemented can protect against 80% of common, internet-borne cyber attacks
- The scheme has two levels, Cyber Essentials is self-certification, and Cyber Essentials Plus is an independent verification of the Cyber Essentials certification
- Now required for many public and private sector contracts, and increasingly required by insurance companies
- Required by the Education Skills Funding Agency, regional councils and the DfE
- Covers five areas of technical controls...

Technical Controls



- Boundary firewalls
- Secure configuration
- Access control
- Malware protection
- Patch Management







What is 'in scope'?

- Any computer which handles your data
- Mobile devices and tablets
- This includes personal devices!
- Firewalls and routers
- Cloud systems such as Microsoft 365
- Consultants and contractors



Why is Cyber Essentials important?

- Sets a standard baseline for cyber hygiene
- Protects against common cyber threats
- Cyber security is linked to data protection
- Increases business resilience and continuity
- Supply chain compliance
- Bigger contracts = more business!

Cyber Essentials Self-Assessment Protos



- 82 questions across the five areas
- Requires gathering a complete list of in-scope assets
- IT or Certification Body support is often required
- Advised to have centralised management of computers and mobiles
- All operating systems and software must be supported
- Password, pin and device locking controls required
- Multi-factor authentication on cloud applications (i.e. M365)
- Controls apply to contractors and BYOD devices



Cyber Essentials Plus Audit



- Test 1 External vulnerability assessment
- Test 2 Authenticated internal vulnerability assessment
- Test 3 Check of malware protection for End User Devices
- Test 4 Checking devices against malware delivered by email
- Test 5 Checking devices against malware delivered by the web
- Test 6 Check multi-factor authentication is enabled
- Test 7 Check of account separation

- ➤ Kooth attracts young people with a range of needs from a variety of different backgrounds




About Qwell.io

- > Qwell is one of the only BACP accredited digital services for adults
- > Qwell offers the same model of care as Kooth
- Over 10 million adults in the UK have access to Qwell
- > Qwell is now available to all adults aged 26+ across Greater Manchester
- ➤ Both Kooth and Qwell have been commissioned by the Greater Manchester Health and Social Care Partnership

At Kooth plc we use a range of appropriate assessment tools for Kooth and Qwell to measure our treatment effectiveness.

Case Management

We keep thorough and encrypted case note records for all service users we support on Kooth and Qwell.

Safeguarding

We are experienced in holding people in crisis and utilising safeguarding principles to govern practice.

Both young people and adults do not need an official referral to Kooth and Qwell to access the respective services. Service users are invited and welcome to join our platforms as long as they fall within the age range that is available to their area.





SEND Provision

Kooth plc ensures our platforms meet the **Web Accessibility Guidelines** (**WCAG**) **2.1 Level AA**. Following these guidelines makes content more accessible to a wider range of people with disabilities, including accommodations for:

- Visual and hearing loss and impairments
- Limited movement
- Language and speech disabilities
- Photosensitivity
- Learning disabilities and cognitive limitations

If someone has any learning difficulties or learning needs, we would look to adapt our approach to their strengths. We are also happy to liaise with other external agencies, if an individual consents to this, to ensure joined up care.

At the same time, the site does rely on text-based interactions, and this may mean that it is not the best or most suitable platform for some individuals with learning difficulties. If this appeared to be the case, we would signpost them to other services that may be able to better meet their needs.
